Some are in the same language FAMILY, so people from one country can often understand the language of people from another country.

Many Europeans are BILINGUAL (speak 2 languages)

or MULTILINGUAL (speak several languages).

These languages families include:

GERMANIC ROMANCE SLAVIC

GERMANIC:

Uses our alphabet.

Examples include German and English.

English is spoken in more parts of the world than any other language.

ROMANCE

Uses our alphabet.

Examples include French and Italian.

The Romance languages are based on Latin, the language of the ancient Romans.

SLAVIC

Uses a Cyrillic alphabet based on ancient Greek letters.

Russian is an example of Slavic language.

There are at least 60 different languages in Europe!




