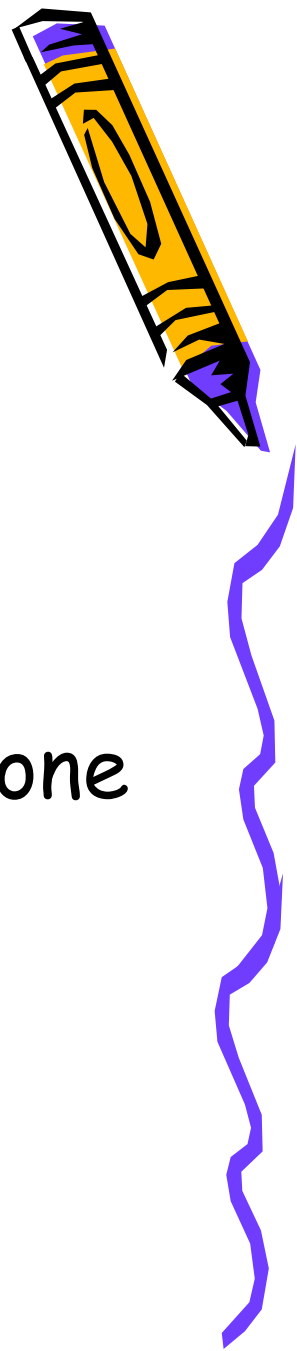

What is an Interactive Notebook?



- A personalized textbook
- A working portfolio - all of your notes, classwork, assignments - in one convenient spot.



Left Side - Right Side Orientation



- The Left side is "left" for you. This is the side that you can use to show me your creativity.
- The Right side is "Restricted" and contains teacher guided notes. Nothing else should be placed on the Right side!!





Left Side-Output



- The left side belongs to you. It contains the day's activity (light bulb). On this page you may include diagrams, cartoons, drawings, poems, foldables, etc. The teacher will assist you.

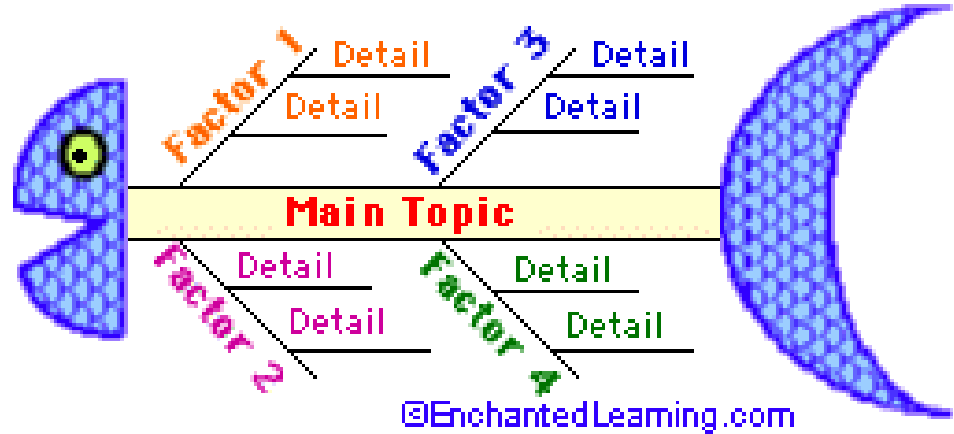

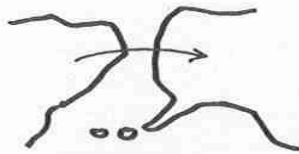
Customs of India

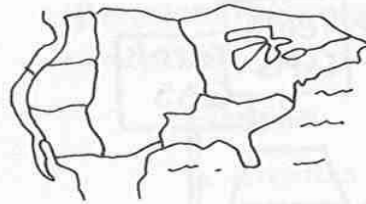

Development of Native American Cultures



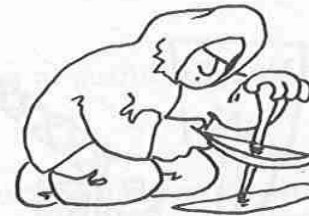
Migrated from Asia

- migrated approximately 20,000-50,000 years ago



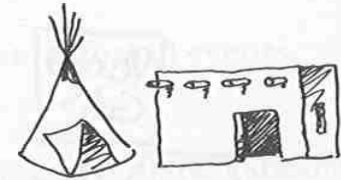
Migrated into Eight Geographic Regions

- Southeast



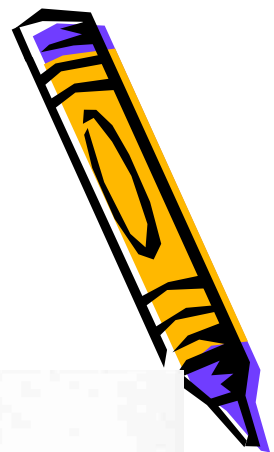
Adapted to Environment

- Nez Percé

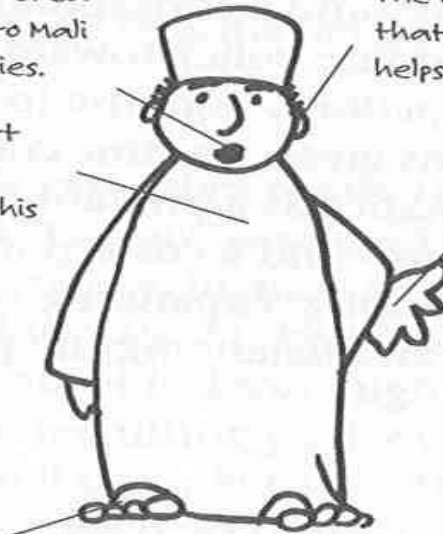


Sensory Figures

I have spoken with Es-Saheli, a Muslim architect, and asked him to return with me to Mali to help redesign our cities.

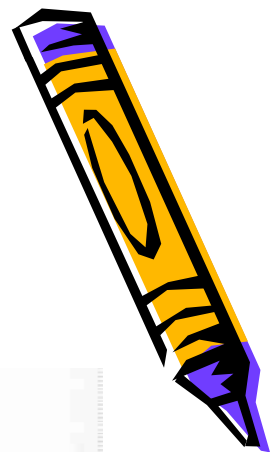
I believe with all my heart that there is no God but Allah, and Muhammad is his prophet.

As I listen to the prayers in the mosque I am reminded that the language of Arabic helps unite all Muslims.

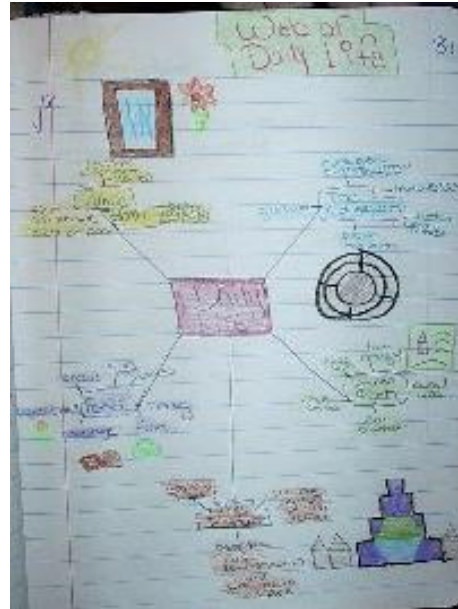
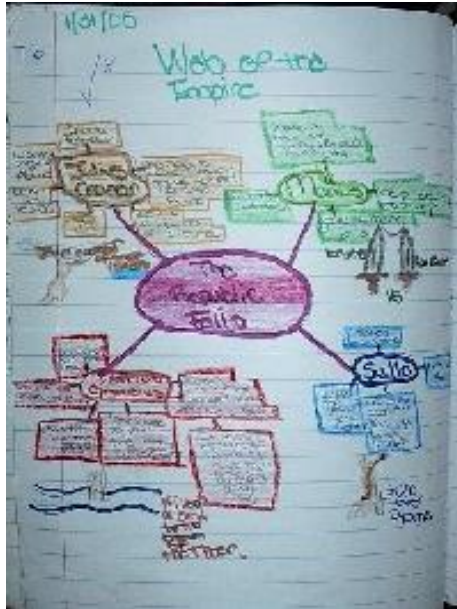
To fulfill the Muslim obligation of zakat, I distributed gold to the people of Cairo with my own hands.



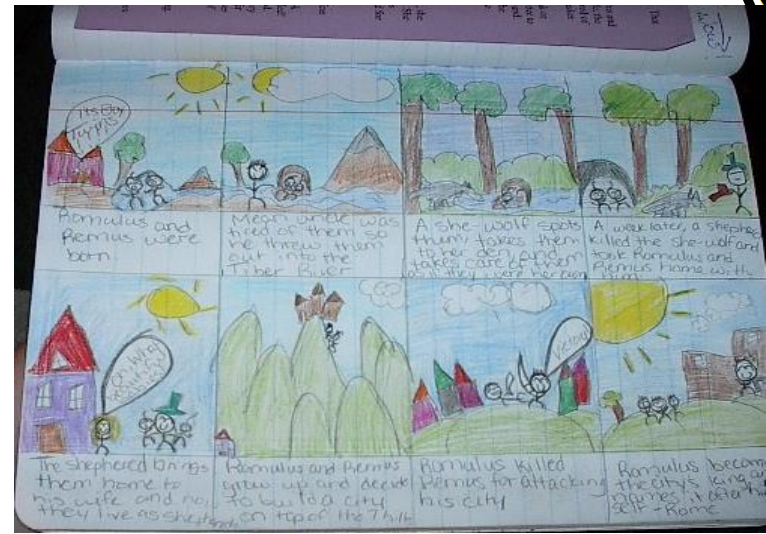
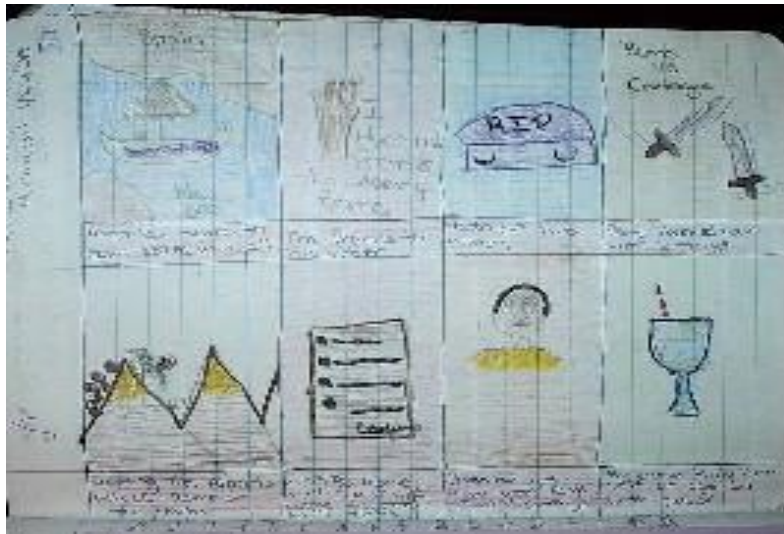

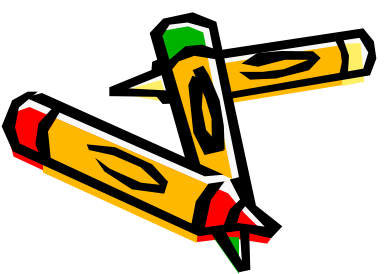
Concept Map



Comic Strips

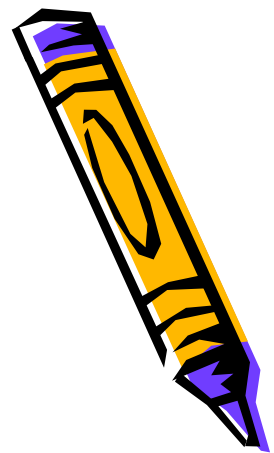


Venn Diagram





Right Side-Input



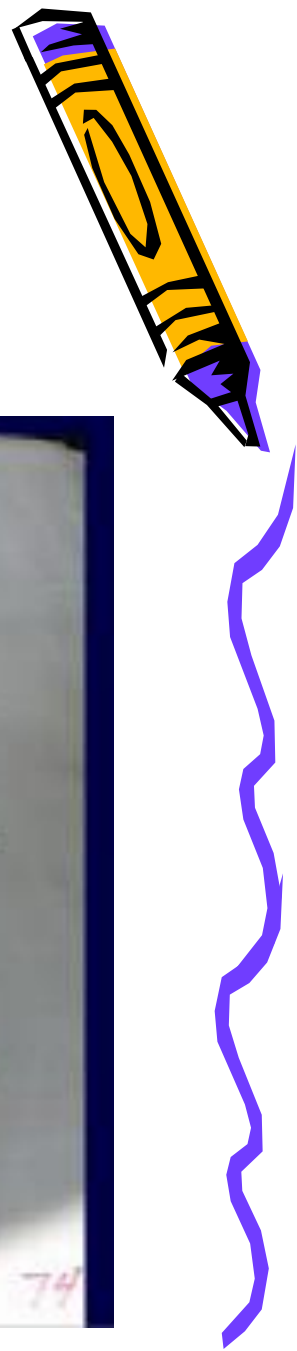
- The right side belongs to me and should only contain teacher directed guided notes. Nothing else should be placed on this page! The right side contains the notepad icon and will contain all the testable material.



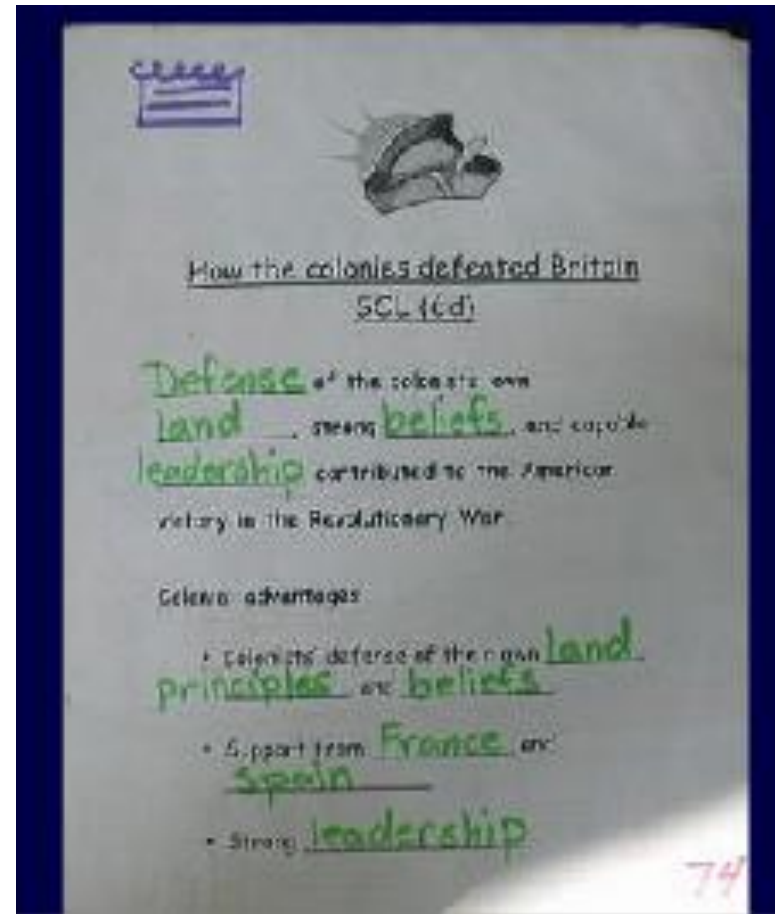
