TOUSSAINT L'OUVERTURE

- Led independence of <u>Haiti</u> from <u>France</u>.
- Wanted to free the <u>black</u> African slaves from their white masters.
- Had no military experience when he became general!







TOUSSAINT L'OUVERTURE'S LIFE

- Born a slave, but granted freedom in 1777.
- Was self-educated.
- Gave himself last name "L'Ouverture" meaning "the opener".



THE HAITIAN REVOLUTION

- 1791-1804
- Marked the only time in history that <u>African</u> <u>slaves</u> successfully rose up to <u>overthrow</u> their European oppressors.
- Inspired by <u>French</u> and <u>American</u> Revolutions.



THE HAITIAN REVOLUTION


- Haitians overtook I/3 of the island with Toussaint
 L'Ouverture as their leader.
- Napoleon tried to send an army to Haiti to put France back in control.
 - Tricked L'Ouverture to come back to France where he was thrown in jail and died of starvation.


WHAT HAPPENED?

- It was not until after his death that the African slaves were able to finally gain their <u>freedom</u>.
- Slavery was <u>abolished</u> and the Haitian republic became the world's first <u>Black republic</u>.

SIMON BOLIVAR


- Led independence movements for Venezuela,
 Colombia, Ecuador, Panama,
 Bolivia, and Peru from Spain.
- As a <u>creole</u> (a person with Spanish parents who was born in Latin America), he was tired of being ruled by <u>European policies</u> that were unfair.








SIMON BOLIVAR'S LIFE

- Was educated in <u>Europe</u> where he learned of the <u>Enlightenment</u> and the French and American Revolutions.
- Known as "El Libertador" and "the George Washington of South America"
- Wanted to combine the countries to make one unified country called "Gran Colombia"



THE FIGHT FOR A GRAN COLOMBIA

- Gained independence for multiple countries over 12 years and became president of Colombia.
- Joined forces with José de San Martin to free Argentina and Chile in the 1810s.
- His "Gran Colombia" splintered in the 1820s and divided after only 12 years.


WHAT HAPPENED?

- Bolivar was <u>successful</u> in his life to liberate countries in South America
- When he realized he was never going to be able to unite South America into one country he retired from politics (with poor health).



• In nearly every town plaza in South America, there is a <u>statue</u> of Bolivar; the country of "Bolivia" is named after him.



- Led independence for Mexico from Spain.

- Wanted to end Spanish oppression of the poor in Mexico.




MIGUEL HIDALGO'S LIFE

- Was a Catholic priest.
- Would host talks at his home about whether it the duty of the people to overthrow an unjust tyrant.
- Known as the "Father of Mexican Independence."



THE FIGHT FOR MEXICAN INDEPENDENCE

- 1810-1821
- Made his famous "Cry for Revolution" in Dolores in 1810 calling for the end of slavery and Spanish rule.
- Took his militia from village to village up to Mexico City.
- Hidalgo was defeated in 1811 and fled, but was <u>captured</u>.

WHAT HAPPENED?


- Hidalgo was executed by the Spanish in 1811
- Revolution continued for II years after Hidalgo's death and slavery was abolished.
