Sutton Middle School is an International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program School. It is a program of international education designed to help students develop the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and skills necessary to participate actively and responsibly in a changing world.

Course Description: Sixth grade is the first year of a two year World Area Studies course. Sixth grade students study Latin America and the Caribbean, Canada, Europe, and Australia. The goal of this two year course is to acquaint middle school students with the world in which they live. The students will learn about both physical and human geography, civic/government, history, culture, and the economics of specified countries around the world.

Grading System: Tests = 25%, Quizzes = 15%, Class work = 20%, Homework = 10%, Projects = 30%. The percentages are subject to change if the teacher deems necessary.

Progress Reports: All students will receive a progress report every four and a half weeks. Please make sure to sign and return the progress report. Absences and Late Work: If a student is absent, he or she will have two days to make up the missing assignments. It is the responsibility of the STUDENT to ask the teacher what assignments he or she has missed. **Late homework is NOT accepted unless the student was absent on the day the homework was assigned...no excuses!** My homework is posted on the board and I send out daily text message alerts via an app. called Remind.
