1. **Autocracy** – A government with a single ruler with unlimited power.
2. **Democracy** – A government that puts the power of the government in the citizens of the country.
3. **Oligarchy** – A government that is ruled by a few.
4. **Monarchy**- a country that is ruled by a monarch (such as a king or queen)
5. **Absolute monarchy**- is a form of government in which the **monarch** has **absolute** power among his or her people. A monarchy that is not limited or restrained by laws or a constitution.
6. **Constitutional Monarchy**- a monarchy in which the powers of the ruler are restricted to those granted under the constitution and laws of the nation.
7. **Dictator**- a ruler with total power over a country, typically one who has obtained power by force.
