- 1. **Triangle Trade** A system in which slaves, crops, and manufactures were traded between Africa, the Caribbean, and the American colonies.
- 2. **Christianity**-is a monotheistic (one god) religion based on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. It is the world's largest religion.
- 3. Catholic A branch or section of Christianity.
- 4. **Ethnic group** a people sharing a common and distinctive culture, religion, language.
- 5. **Mestizo** An ethnic group whose ancestors were both European and Native American.
- 6. **Mulatto** An ethnic group whose ancestors were both African and European.
- 7. **Miguel Hidalgo** Mexican priest who led the country to independence from the Spanish. Known as the Father of Mexican Independence.
- 8. **Simon Bolivar** South American soldier who helped many countries gain independence from the Spanish; founded Bolivia in 1825. Known as the George Washington of South American and the El Libertador.
- 9. **Toussaint L'Ouverture** A Haitian slave who led a slave revolt against the French and helped to create the new country of Haiti.
